Diversity Enhancement Scholarship

All application material must be received by May 1 for consideration. The Diversity Enhancement Scholarship is funded by donations from the campus campaign or outside donations that chose to contribute to IUPUC scholarships. This is a one-time \$1,000 award for the academic year (\$500 in fall and \$500 in spring).

Eligible recipients must be a resident of Indiana, a student of diverse ethnicity and multicultural background, enrolled full-time with a minimum 12 credit hours, and enrolled in a degree program that can be completed in its entirety at IUPUC. Only complete applications received by May 1 will be considered. Priority is given to first-year incoming freshmen, however, previous recipients and transfer students may apply.
