



# *Scholarship renewal criteria for Pathway Scholarship*

## Award

- Enclosed is a scholarship acceptance form and renewal criteria detailing information about your scholarship. Before scholarships will award to your IU Bursar account, a completed acceptance form must be returned.
- Scholarships are fall/spring awards and will credit to your IUPUC bursar account ten days before your first day of classes; if scholarship exceeds the amount due, a refund is issued by a mailed check or direct deposit to your bank.

## Communication

- Office of Scholarships regularly sends formal communications via IU email regarding your scholarship status/maintenance, volunteering, and other scholarship opportunities. You must check your IU email regularly.

## Enrollment

- You must enroll full-time (12 or more credit hours) each semester at IUPUC campus.
- If your enrollment falls below 12 credit hours in a semester the Office of Scholarships must be notified.
- If you withdraw from all classes, the scholarship may be reduced depending on the refund period and will not be awarded the following and the remaining scholarship will be forfeited.
- If 24 credits are not completed within the first calendar year the scholarship will be forfeited and not eligible for reinstatement.
  - A minimum of nine credits must be successfully completed each semester the scholarship is received for the scholarship to renew (F's, W's, and I's do not count as completed courses).
- You enrollment is verified each semester.

## Duration

- Pathway Scholarship is renewable for three semesters (four semesters total) of undergraduate study, not including summer.
- Your scholarship is forfeited if you graduates before the four semesters.

## GPA

- You must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA each semester.
- If your GPA falls below the required 3.0, you may submit a reinstatement form to the Office of Scholarship, within the four semesters, once you meet the eligibility requirements.

## Volunteer

- A student must volunteer for one approved campus event per semester (minimum of two hours per event). Volunteer verification form or confirmation from event coordinator must be received by the Office of Scholarships.
- Volunteer opportunities are sent to your IU email account and are filled on a first respond basis
- If a student does not meet the volunteer requirement in a semester the scholarship will be placed on "probation." The student will need to volunteer for two events the following semester. If at the end of the probation semester two events have not been completed the scholarship will be forfeited and there will not be an option for reinstatement

## Degree requirement

- To receive and renew the Pathway Scholarship student must be admitted and enrolled in a degree program that can be completed at IUPUC.
  - Eligible programs are: business, communication studies, English, general studies, mechanical engineering, nursing, psychology, or sociology.
  - If you are no longer enrolled in one of these programs your scholarship will no longer be valid.
